3. The School Almanac should be checked and counter signed by the Parents regularly.
4. Label all the belongings of your ward with permanent marker.
5. Ensure that the nails of your ward should be trimmed every Sunday and the hair (for non – Sikh children) should be cut when needed (once in a month) as there will be a regular surprise check. (For non – sikh boys crew cut is mandatory)

6. Neatness of notebooks, books and handwriting will be evaluated in each assessment.
7. The Books and the notebooks should be covered with transparent plastic cover and write the name and class on them.
8. Parents are requested to follow the rules Strictly otherwise your ward's name will be entered in the defaulter's list.
9. Lay emphasis on spoken english.
10. Birthday celebrations are not allowed in school. So kindly don't Send any gifts in the school for the distribution. In order to inculcate the feelings of empathy in your ward, the parents should take them to religious places, orphanage, old age home etc. For extending a helping hand to the deprived ones.

Saturday	Kids Choice Day (Food with Multi Nutrients)	French Fries, Smileys, Vegetable Sandwich, Vegetable Cutlets, Vegetable Pasta, Pav Bhaji etc.

- ❖ Parents should send one small fruit/ Salad tiffin daily.
- ❖ Please ensure not to over stuff the tiffin box or send junk foods like wafer, chips, salted namkeen, or fill water bottle with soda based soft drinks.
