Tuesday (Iron / Vitamins)	Green Day Green Vegetable, Spinach/Stuffed Parantha, Black Gram (Chana) Puri, Sarson da Saag and Makki di Roti etc.
Wednesday (Carbohydrates)	Rice Day Idli Vada, Veg.Pulao, Veg.Fried Rice, Veg.Poha, Rajma Rice etc.
Thursday (Proteins)	Soya Day Soya granules/nuggets, Sprouts, Pulses etc.
Friday (Iron / Vitamins)	Green Day Green Vegetable, Spinach/Fenugreek Parantha, Black Gram (Chana) Puri, Sarson da Saag and Makki di Roti etc.
Saturday (Food with Multi Nutrients)	Kids Choice Day French Fries, Smileys, Vegetable Burger, Vegetable Cutlets, Vegetable Pasta, Pav Bhaji etc.

- ❖ Parents should send one small fruit/ Salad tiffin daily.
